FROM INSPIRATION TO IMPLEMENTATION

Echo 2025 inspired hundreds of leaders to take bold steps in evangelism. One missions pastor reflected, “I came home transformed and am eager to put into practice all that I learned.” For many, that next step was the **Church Assessment**, launched at Echo 2025. Churches used the tool to identify gaps in prayer, advocacy, and sending. One leader noted, “The process was eye-opening – it gave us a roadmap for mobilization.” This combination of vision and practical tools exemplifies Missio Nexus’ commitment to equipping the Great Commission community. CONNECTING CHURCHES TO THE UNREACHED

In 2025, Missio Nexus partnered with Switchboard to launch the **Church Kit**, a resource designed to help congregations advocate for unreached people groups. The kit includes prayer guides, digital assets, and engagement ideas for local churches. Early adopters reported strong participation: “Our members loved the tangible ways to connect with global needs,” said one missions leader. 2025 was a landmark year for Missio Nexus. Here's what we accomplished together:



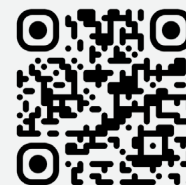

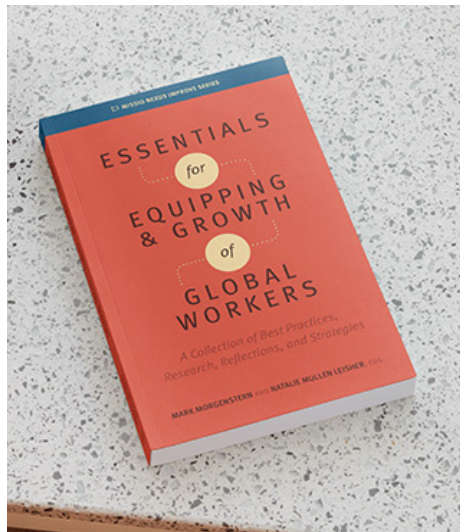
Mission Leaders Conference (Echo 2025) achieved our highest-ever **Net Promoter Score of 70**, with workshops and networking rated most valuable.

Church Missions Assessment Tool launched in three phases: pilot in September, member rollout at Echo, and public access in October.

A Third of Us Alliance was consolidated under Missio Nexus and kicked off a multi-year awareness campaign in November.

Support Missio Nexus in equipping mission leaders to grow in their role, make new connections, and gain a global perspective. Together, we can strengthen Great Commission mobilization and unlock the potential for church missions success.





Tracks 365 communications began in December, paving the way for year-round learning in 2026.

Two major publications debuted at Echo: *Missiology for Missions Pastors* and *Essentials for Equipping and Growth of Global Workers*.

We expanded member benefits with a **Logos Bible Software discount** and advanced innovation through three **Sprint Cohorts** involving 30+ organizations.

Through the Innovation Fund, we partnered with **Switchboard** to launch the Church Kit, equipping congregations to advocate for the unreached.

Missio Nexus 2025 Highlights

In 2025, Missio Nexus invested deeply in community learning and collaboration. Echo 2025 brought together over 1,000 mission leaders for four plenary sessions, 64 workshops, and 13 networking events. Beyond the conference, we curated quarterly issues of *EMQ*, hosted webinars on mobilization and compliance, and facilitated Innovation Cohorts that helped agencies tackle real-world challenges.

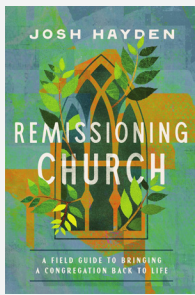

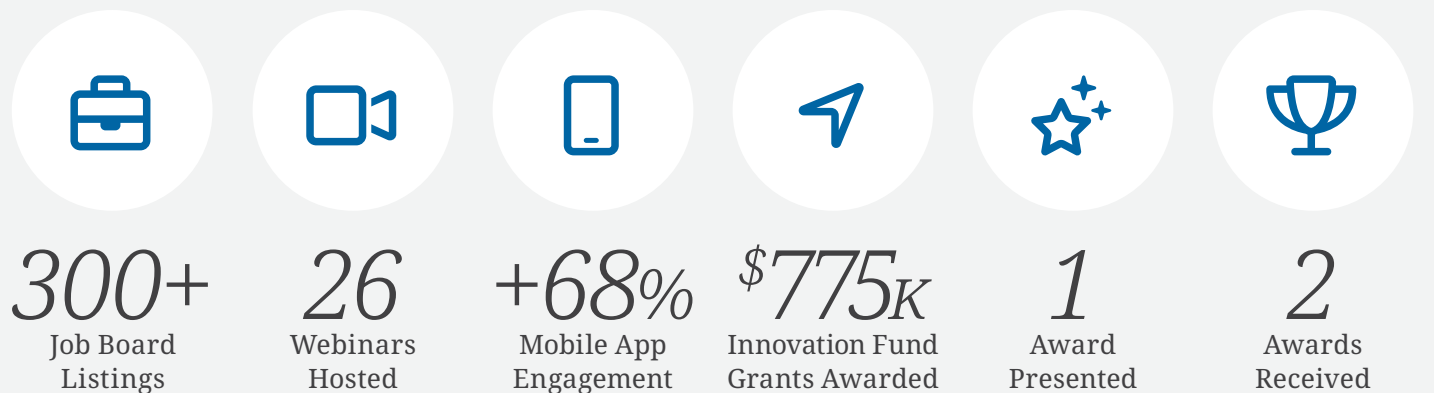

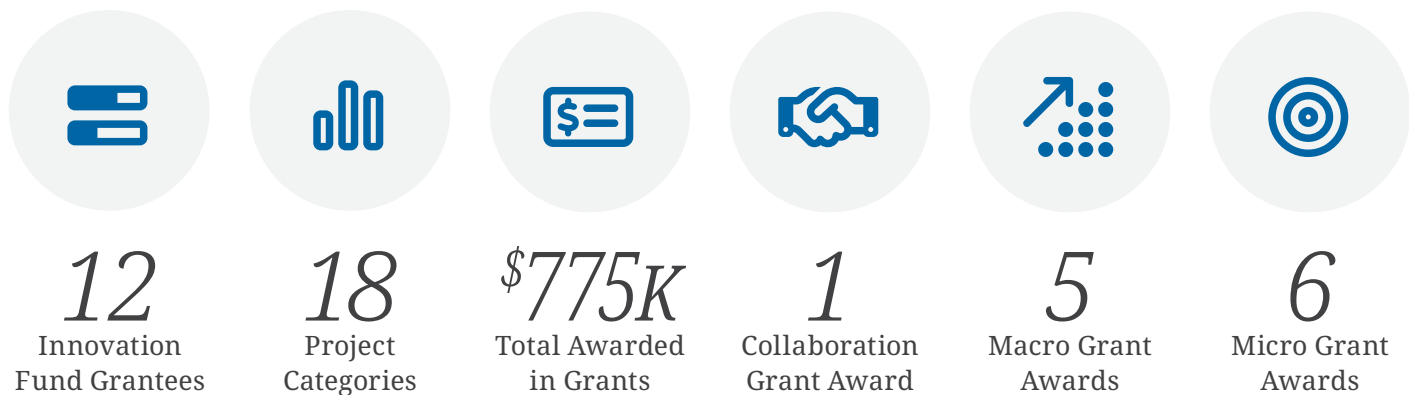
THE 2025 MISSIO NEXUS INNOVATION FUND CONTINUED TO CHAMPION INNOVATIVE THINKING, supporting groundbreaking efforts that spanned AI-driven discipleship tools, media for evangelism, leadership development, church planting, training initiatives, and resources for national and indigenous ministries.

Collaboration Grants awarded to outstanding alliances demonstrating unity and innovation: Entrepreneurial Church Network of Israel (collaborative partnership between Jews for Jesus and FIRM).

Macro Grants with broad potential influence awarded to: IMB, Launch Global, MENA KDEC Ministries, New Generations, and Renew World Outreach.

Micro Grants supporting smaller, impactful projects: Assemblies of God World Mission, Equipping Farmers International, Global Gates, SAT-7, TEAM, and Trans World Radio.

Global Leadership Gatherings

In 2025, Missio Nexus hosted ten in-person gatherings, highlighted by the Echo Mission Leaders Conference in Orlando, where over 1,000 mission leaders united to network, share best practices, and rally around the urgent call to evangelism. Our expanded virtual programming included quarterly webinars, innovation cohorts, and peer learning groups, while four prayer gatherings brought together participants to intercede for the unreached.

Through these catalytic events, we equipped church and agency leaders to advance gospel proclamation and mobilize the Great Commission community for bold evangelistic impact.

TWO LEADING 10X EVENTS prepare women for greater responsibility in their roles as executive leaders.

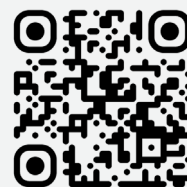

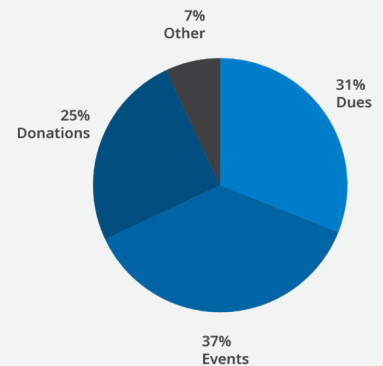

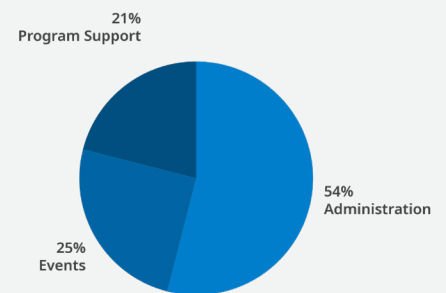
